



Checking the level requires lifting the plastic lid of the screenwash reservoir and filling with water and/or screenwasher fluid until fluid can be seen at the top of the filler neck, then replacing the lid.

(207 along with many cars now does not have an actual fluid level indicator to show half-full etc.)

Note: When you have your own car, screenwasher fluid is bought ready-mixed or in concentrated form for mixing with water in proportions according to the weather. In winter the concentration will be higher to prevent the fluid in the reservoir from freezing. Instructions are given on the fluid containers.

The test simply requires you to point to the reservoir and describe how to check and top-up the screenwasher fluid.
